**RE: January 24, 2014 Letter Request for Extension of Time to Comply with
Ordering Paragraph 21 in Decision 13-09-044**

Dear Ms. Prince:

I am in receipt of your letter dated January 24, 2013. On behalf of Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas), your letter requests the suspension of the requirements of Ordering Paragraph (OP) 21 of Decision (D.) 13-09-044 "until such time as the Commission has established a revised schedule of requirements. San Diego Gas & Electric Company, Southern California Edison Company, and Pacific Gas and Electric Company support this request."

OP 21 states:

Beginning January 31, 2014, the California Hub for Energy Efficiency Financing (CHEEF), in conjunction with Southern California Edison Company, Pacific Gas and Electric Company, Southern California Gas Company, and San Diego Gas & Electric Company (IOUs), shall file and serve a Fourth Quarter 2013 Report, and quarterly reports thereafter through the pilot period, by pilot program and on CHEEF operational expenses.

Your letter describes how D.13-09-044 recognized that a CHEEF might not be in place by January 15, 2014. In that case, OP 25 of D.13-09-044 directed SoCalGas to file a petition to modify D.13-09-044 "to determine which entity can best provide the CHEEF function." Your letter states that a CHEEF was in fact not in place by January 15, 2014, and that SoCalGas has accordingly filed the required petition to modify on January 24, 2014.

I grant SoCalGas' request for a suspension of the requirements of OP 21 to file quarterly reports as described in Ordering Paragraph 21 of D.13-09-044. I further grant the request to toll the regulatory requirements and estimated scheduling set out in D.13-09-044 until the Commission makes the determination "which entity can best provide the CHEEF functions" and establishes revised requirements and scheduling. In accordance with Rule 16.6 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, please inform all parties to this proceeding of these extensions.
